ESTROFEST PRODUCTIONS, INC., an Atlanta-based arts production company, is seeking woman positive theater, film/video, dance, spoken word, performance art, guerilla art, music and visual art for the third annual SEEN + HEARD FESTIVAL "CONCEIVE!" from **June 15-19, 2005**. The five-day Festival will take place in THE B COMPLEX's historic 8,000 square foot Gallery. Submissions open to all genders (trans-inclusive).

Submissions should demonstrate the artist's interpretation of the THEME.

Theater: Send script. Only plays with minimal sets can be considered.

Film/video: send VHS or DVD.

Dance: send VHS or DVD of work sample + description of intended performance

Spoken word: send writing sample (8 pages maximum)

Performance art: send VHS or DVD work sample + description of intended performance

Guerilla art: send still images, VHS, or DVD of past work + description of intended work

Music: send CD or cassette

Visual art: send slides (one sleeve maximum). Submissions can be composed of any visual art medium such as painting, drawing, photography, sculpture, ceramics, glass, installation, audio and video. (EstroFest Productions' commissions on all sales will be 10%.)

Submissions should also include a \$10 entry fee (U.S. check or money order made payable to EstroFest Productions, Inc.) per artist. All submissions should be a maximum of 20 minutes. The entry fee covers a maximum of three submissions per artist for consideration. Visual artists are asked to send slides (by mail) or jpegs (by email). Please provide artist statements, bios, contact information and specific technical needs for your work. In addition, also provide a SASE if you desire the return of materials.

DEADLINE for submissions is FRIDAY, MARCH 19th, 2005. Accepted artists will be notified via email or phone. Accepted artwork must reach EstroFest Productions, Inc. by Sunday, June 5, 2005. **The Seen + Heard Festival 2005 has received some funding, but still runs on volunteer fuel. We apologize that we cannot offer financial remuneration at this time.**
